

2nd China-Japan-Korea Track 2 Meeting for Cybersecurity

Co-Chairs' Statement

China Institute of International Studies (CIIS), in cooperation with Keio University and Korea University, hosted the 2nd China-Japan-Korea Track 2 Meeting for Cybersecurity in Beijing on 12 October 2017.

Experts from the People's Republic of China, Japan and the Republic of Korea engaged in an in-depth discussion on the latest development of cyber legislation in the three countries, the latest international development in the field of cyber security, critical infrastructure in the context of cybersecurity, computer emergency response, and China-Japan-Korea cyber relations.

We agreed to continue the dialogue process and further promote research on such issues as cyber laws, cyber crime, critical infrastructure in the context of cybersecurity, concepts, terminologies and other issues of common concern, with a view to finding the common understanding and differences among the three countries on cyber issues, exploring a cooperative approach for the peaceful use of cyberspace, building regional consensus on cyber issues, and contributing to global cooperation on cyberspace.

The first meeting was held in Seoul in November 2016. Keio University will host the third meeting in 2018.
