

KGRI Working Papers

Working papers at the Keio University Global Research Institute (KGRI) are made available on the KGRI website by its researchers and participants in its research projects before their research results are officially announced in academic journals or books, etc., for use and discussion by researchers both inside and out of KGRI. Various versions of papers are made available before and during the peer review process.

The copyright and responsibility for the content of a working paper published on the website reside with the author. Inquiries on the content of a paper are dealt with directly by the author via e-mail. Please follow any instructions provided for citing the paper. The prior approval of the author must be obtained to use a working paper for other activities, including posts on other digital bulletin boards and archives.

Be aware that a working paper shall be deleted from the website without prior notice upon the request of the author in cases where the copyright has been transferred to another party following its official announcement / publication, etc.

Submission guidelines

1. Submission criteria

Researchers of KGRI and participants in KGRI research projects.

2. Regarding papers

- In principle, papers are to be written in a language other than Japanese. There are no specific stipulations for format and style.
- Attach an abstract for the paper in Japanese and English along with a cover sheet in the specified format.

Cover sheet: Fill in the title (Japanese and English), KGRI project code, names of authors, version, and contact e-mail address in the prescribed form.

Provide any instructions for citing the paper.

Graduate students should provide the name of their research advisor.

Japanese language abstract: within 400 characters.

English language abstract: within 200 words.

*Please inform us if it will be difficult to submit a Japanese language abstract.

3. Method of submission

Upon obtaining the approval of the research project leader, send the main text (PDF), cover sheet (Word), Japanese language abstract (Word), and English language abstract (Word) to the following e-mail address for submissions: kgri-wp@adst.keio.ac.jp

4. Other information

Although an arbitrary name may be used for the file when submitting, the file name shall be replaced based on the following rule when published on the website:

KGRI project code + receipt date of e-mail .pdf

Inform us as soon as possible when it becomes necessary to delete a working paper from the KGRI website because the copyright has been transferred to another party following its official announcement / publication, etc.
